



## RTMM MedEvac Dispatch #E037B

Recommended Vehicle: Helo or Tundra/Ski

Scenery Needed: SIRP

### Nature of Emergency:

- Expedition lost, no radio reception, assuming an accident. Three people involved, last contact bearing was 020° from SCR8 (Saddle Camp). Locate, and if a medical emergency exists, take the victims to Scud River Trauma Centre, way point M033B

### Location of Emergency:

- Unknown, last contact on a 020° bearing from Saddle Camp.

### Medical Destination and Way Points:

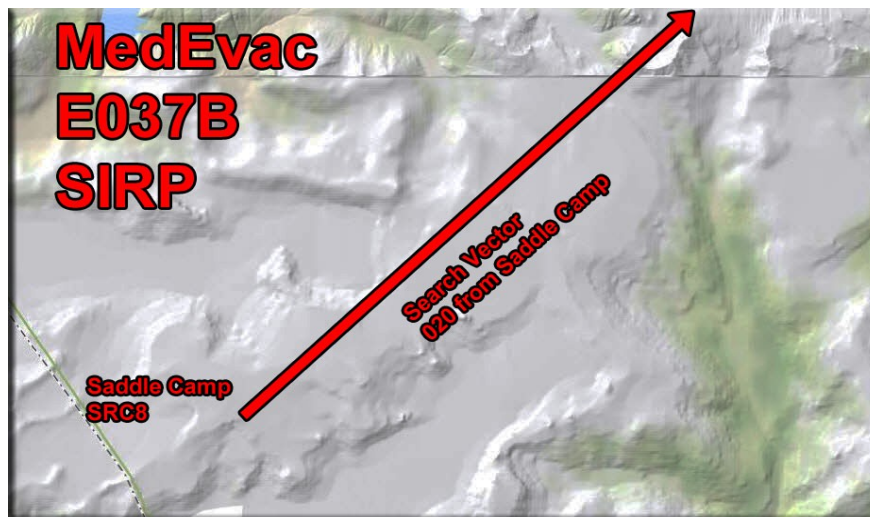
- Scud River Trauma Centre **Heli:** M033B **Wheeled:** M033B at CAB6

### Starting Location: SIRP Saddle Camp (SRC8)

- Helicopter:** "Go to Airport" SRC8
- Tundra/Ski:** "Go to Airport" SRC8

### Special Instructions:

- Start at Saddle Camp (SIRP SRC8). Set ADF for "258". Fly on a 020° magnetic bearing or use the ADF and fly 20 degrees reciprocal bearing. Search for a yellow snow cat. There are three passengers on board. When located, land nearby and assess situation. If there are medical emergencies, fly them to the Scud River Trauma Center at way point M033B.



**NOTAM:** *This dispatch is very difficult. This is an example of how difficult search and rescue can be in dangerous terrain. The area is VAST, and the accident scene is TINY. Most of the RTMM MedEvacs will have way points ... but we wanted to give you one that would duplicate this more dangerous situation.*
