



## RTMM MedEvac Dispatch #E041B

Recommended Vehicle: Helicopter or Amphibian

Scenery Needed: ORBX PNW

### Nature of Emergency:

- Small Aircraft has crashed into a Electrical Utility Pylon. The pilot has been rescued and brought down to the water's edge. Multiple injuries. Needs immediate transport to St Paul's Hospital in Vancouver, BC.

### Starting Location: Sechelt-Gibsons Airport (CAP3)

- **Helicopter:** CAP3 Helipad
- **Amphibian:** CAP3 Fuel Box at Parking 1

### Location of Emergency:

- N49 23.6056 W123 8.6221 **Way Point:** E041B [Topo Map](#)
- Bearing from CAB3 is 081° at a distance of 26.8 miles.

### Medical Destination and Way Points:

- St Pauls Hospital Annex: **Helo:** M034H **Amphib:** M034D
- (Vancouver Plus Helo: M034V at St Paul's Vancouver)

### Special Instructions:

- **Helicopter:** Start at the helipad at CAP3, Sechelt-Gibsons Airport. Set the GPS for the way point of E041B. The accident is in the reservoir above Cleveland Dam. There is a very small landing area near the water's edge near the orange smoke. Pick up the victim and proceed to St Paul's Hospital M034H (or M034V for Vancouver Plus).
- **Amphibian:** Start at Parking 1 Fuel Box at Sechelt-Gibsons Airport (CAP3). Set the way point of E041B on the GPS. You can land in the water reservoir above the Cleveland dam and taxi to the shoreline where the victim is waiting. Look for the orange smoke marker. Proceed to the St Paul's Hospital Medical Dock M034D.
