Equipment: Helicopter/ Amphib
ATV Quad Accident

Special RTMM Scenery Requirements:

- ORBX SAK
- ORBX PAJN Juneau
- TF20 Gilbert Bay v2
- NAC Bases

Starting Location:

NACR NAC Randolph Peak, Ak, USA

Location of Emergency:

Bearing from Randolph Peak is 077° for 13 nm

Medical Destination:

Bartlett Regional, Juneau, Ak, USA at waypoint M001H, M001F respectively

Nature of Emergency:

ATV Quad crash in a little creek close to a tourist cabin. Man and girlfriend injured. The woman was transported to MM hangar at Gilbert Bay Airstrip for fixed wing evac. The injured driver is still at first aid treatment at the emergency location and waits for helo evac. Medical status unknown. Give fast professional help and transport the victims to Trauma Centre Bartlett Regional, Juneau, Ak.

Emergency Location: TF20 Gilbert Bay Airstrip and remote cabin.

Emergency Way point:

Helo evac: Set the GPS to waypoint E045H. Fly a heading of 077° and touch down directly next to the accident location, yellow smoke is depicted. After having stabilized the patient give a fast transport to Bartlett Regional M001H. Shut down your helo at 18AK North Douglas Heliport, Juneau just on the other side of Gastineau Channel.

Amphib Evac: Set the GPS to waypoint E045F. Fly a heading of 077° for 13 nm. Land on the dirt strip of Gilbert Bay and taxi to the hangar. Pick up the injured young lady and fly her to Bartlett Regional M001F medical dock quickly.
