Location Information:

Boat Mooring at Rwy 7 Pier: N54 33.21 W128 28.57 Heading 228

Aircraft/Helicopter Parking: N54 33.20 W128 28.33 Alt 273

Runway Position (25): N54 33.18 W128 28.15 Heading 250

Float Plane Position: N54 33.20 W128 28.58 Heading 228

“The main lodge is situated near the shore of beautiful Lake Ise Lake, in close proximity to the Skeena River, Kitimat River and the city of Terrace. This location provides accommodation for four anglers in a handcrafted post and beam cabin.

Our rustic cabin provides all the basics to ensure you are well rested and well fed. We have hot showers, comfortable bunks and single beds along with simple, wholesome home-cooked meals to ensure you eat well and get a good night’s sleep. We are all about fishing, not fancy.

Don’t expect champagne or roast duck but you can count on a nice steak or lasagne. Because we aren’t fancy, we don’t charge fancy prices. We are focused on the fishing, and that is why we are a real fly fishing lodge.”

RTMM will be using the Skeena River Lodge location as a jumping off point for boating adventures on the Skeena River area. We will have flight-seeing trips as well as fishing trips to the areas serviced by the real Skeena River Lodge.

Installation:

When you open the zip file, you find the following:

1. VFR map and flight plan for Helicopters from Terrace CBW5 to the Skeena River Lodge
2. VFR map and flight plan for planes from Terrace, BC CYXT to the Skeena River Lodge
3. A “Skeena River Lodge” folder. This goes into where ever you add your addon scenery folders. (Don't forget to activate the scenery in FSX)
