



**RTMM MedEvac Dispatch #E011B - July 4th 2:00 PM Local
Equipment: Helicopter or Amphibian
Spud's Creek – Bear Attack**

Special RTMM Scenery Requirements:

- Spud's Creek
- Wilson River Lodge
- ORBX PFJ

Starting Location: PF25 Wilson River Lodge

Dispatch Location: E011B - Bearing from PF25 054° for 16 miles

Destination: CAC3 Alice Arm Remote Emergency Center – Waypoint M016B

Nature of Emergency: Bear Attack, One person hurt. The Bear is still in the vicinity, depart aircraft cockpit only if armed. The patient must be transported quickly to the Alice Arm Remote Emergency Center for stabilization.

Emergency Location: N55 30.1944 --- W130 56.3050 - Altitude: 0 Feet --- [Topo Map](#)

Emergency Waypoint: E011B

- **Helicopter:** Set the GPS for waypoint E011B. Departure location is the Wilson River Lodge PF25. You will fly on a heading of 054° for 16 miles. There are some clear areas for landing relatively near the cabin. Be sure to be armed before leaving the cockpit, there is a bear in the area. Secure and transport the patient to the Alice Arm Remote Emergency Center at waypoint M016B. They will be ready for you at the dock area.
- **Amphibian:** Set the GPS for waypoint E011B. Departure location is the Wilson River Lodge PF25. You will fly on a heading of 054° for 16 miles. There is a short, straight waterway for landing and approaching the cabin. Approach heading is 252° for landing and taxiing to the cabin. Be sure to be armed before leaving the cockpit, there is a bear in the area. Secure and transport the patient to the Alice Arm Remote Emergency Center at waypoint M016B. They will be ready for you at the dock area.

NOTAM: Dangerous Approach for Amphibian, narrow and short waterway.
