



RTMM MedEvac Dispatch #E023H
Equipment: Helicopter Only
Mountain Climbing Accident – Cape Spencer

Special RTMM Scenery Requirements:

- Tongass X

Starting Location: Cape Spencer Light Helipad

- Helicopter: Cape Spencer: Position at: N58 11.9579 W136 38.3860 Altitude 134'
(Be sure to put in the altitude of 134 Feet)

Location of Emergency: Bearing from Cape Spencer is 308° for 30 miles. Altitude: 6883'

Medical Destination:

Helicopter: Juneau's Bartlett Regional Helipad: way point: M001H

Nature of Emergency: Mountain climbing accident. A fall with several broken bones. Will need immediate transport to Bartlett Regional. Be prepared for shock and compound fracture triage. One of the climbers has deployed orange smoke to help you find their location. Pick up the injured person and the other one in the party and transport to Juneau.

Emergency Location: N58 33.7475 W137 3.2330 [Topo Map](#)

Emergency Waypoint: E023H

- **Helicopter:** Position the helicopter exactly at N58 11.9579 W136 38.3860 at an altitude of 134'. This will place you on the helipad at Cape Spencer. Set your GPS way point for E023H. From here, fly 308 degrees for 30 miles, climbing to an altitude of about 7000 feet. There is an orange smoke bomb being deployed at the emergency site. You have one person severely injured and another person who is not injured. Both will need transport. Pick them up and transport them to Bartlett Regional in Juneau, landing on the helipad at M001H.
