

This is the Return to Misty Moorings "Refreshed" logo. When this is present for a scenery location on the RTMM Scenery page, it means the location has been "refreshed". You should look at the date of the "refreshed: xx.xx.xxxx" and make sure you have the latest.

RTMM has about 700+ locations you can fly to. We will be adding a new one now and then, but most people have not even flown all of the ones we have. So we are focusing on going back to bring the older versions up-to-date with the latest technology and "tricks" we have learned over the past few years. We'll be updating the README FIRST text file for each of them making sure the correct information is depicted.

We will still be adding new locations now and then, but our focus is going to be on some housekeeping this year to bring all of our data up to date and make it accurate for you.

If you see one of the readme files that is very wrong, let us know and we'll prioritize that one for "refreshment."

When you see a RED Exclamation Mark, it means there is a new, refreshed version of the scenery available that you can download using the zip button at the scenery location.

When you see a GREEN Check Mark, it means a change was made, but the scenery files were not affected. Usually this means we updated the Readme text files. So there is no need to re-download the scenery files. If you have the location, you have the latest version.

If your favorite scenery has a Red Exclamation Mark, it doesn't mean that what you already have will stop working. It simply means that there is a BETTER version available for you to redownload.

REMEMBER!!!! Delete the old folder before you add the new folder!

When you are adding an update, if you have an older version ALWAYS DELETE the old folder in your Addon Scenery folder first, then put in the new "updated" folder. We are keeping the names the same for you so your Scenery Library will not have to be altered. Often we change file naming "inside" the folder and if you overwrite, you will have inadvertent duplicate bgl that will cause you problems!
