INTRODUCTION & FEATURES

Welcome to beautiful Waterfall, Alaska. This is the site of an historic cannery that was once one of the largest in the state. The fishing around this area today is still how money is made, but not by putting fish into cans, but by putting fishermen into a plush lodge converted from a cannery and into a boat with a guide. With our rendition of Waterfall, we have added a little of both worlds.

You will find Waterfall at: N55 17.66 W133 15.10 Mag 50*

The scenery location offers the following features:

<u>A Waterfall at Waterfall</u> Yes there is a waterfall at Waterfall. You will find it about 2 miles to "port" of the village as you are facing the shore.

<u>The Boardwalk at Waterfall</u> You can walk all the way from the restaurant area almost 2 miles to the seaplane dock at the far end of the boardwalk. And all the way, the boardwalk is landscaped. You can walk out on a cabin deck, or stop by the market area at town square and enjoy sitting at the bench and watching the activity. Nearby is a Brad's BBQ, and you know how good that is for lunch!

<u>The Cannery</u> The cannery is active and comes complete with Helipad. This "object" was part of the original Tongass X Scenery.

<u>Fishing with the Nets</u> You will find a fishing boat pulling a net, and within the net are salmon jumping with hungry gulls overhead.

<u>Mountain Top Lodge</u> High above Waterfall, and looking down on the town and the waterfall area is Mountain Top Lodge, again complete with helipad.

<u>Al Traffic (Planes & Boats)</u> There will be plenty for you to see and do at Waterfall, even if you are only sitting on a dock and watching the area around you. There are three Al float planes taking off and landing regularly. One is to the port side of the cannery, the other two are at the starboard end of the scenery. We are also updating TFAISP, the Tongass Fjords A.I. Shipping Project to include many fishing boats for Waterfall. INSTALLATION

Unzip this file to a temporary folder.

Place the "Waterfall" folder where you place your FSX "Addon Scenery". We recommend FSX/Addon Scenery/Misty Moorings/Waterfall

Start up FSX

Go to "Settings"

Then to "Scenery Library"

Click on "Add Area"

Click on "Addon Scenery"

Locate the newly installed folder for this package you just moved into your "Addon Scenery" folder of FSX

Click on the main folder only. You do NOT need to open the "scenery" folder.

Then click on "OK"

And then "OK" again.

FSX should begin to recompile your scenery library.

NOTAM: Be sure to download the latest TFAISP file to see the fishing boats.

NOTAM: Tongass Fjords X is needed for this scenery to work.

ADDING FISHING BOAT TRAFFIC

If you also want to enable fishing boat traffic, copy the Traffic_MMC9.bgl file to your FSX\Scenery\World\Scenery folder and you should see a lot of boats departing during the first 30 minutes after 1600 GMT.
